# Teaching Themes

## HEALING:

The first Sunday of every month is an opportunity for an unhurried time around the "LORD's Table" to share in the breaking of bread and wine.

During the first eight months of 2010 Frank has been exploring what God's word has to say on the subject of healing. The main emphasis of his teaching during this time has looked at the area of healing that it sometimes understood as inner healing. Together we have explored the meaning of salvation as wholeness spirit, soul body. We have endeavoured to come into a greater degree of freedom in Christ, looking at issues of bondage breaking strongholds and dealing with roots of bitterness.

As we come into the last quarter of this month we want to focus on healing as signs of the kingdom. We will look at healing in the context of Corinthians 12 & 14 gifts of the spirit. We will have a guest speaker exploring "healing on our streets"

## THE BEATITUDES

Since January we have been looking at Jesus' teaching from Matthew 5. The gospel summaries in a few verses Jesus' teaching over several hours, so we have spent several hours unpacking a few verses, and as we've done so, started to feel scriptures devastating challenge to our hearts and motives. (Hb 4 : 12)

We continue from September onwards by considering how the gospel teaches us to handle persecution, practical advice on kingdom living, and the heart.

# Teaching Themes

## LESSONS FROM MARK:

The Book of Mark is the shortest of the four Gospels and probably the earliest one written down. It is not as detailed as Matthew, not as clinically precise as Luke, nor as sermon-like as John. Mark probably was able to talk to people first-hand and, because of this, we can learn so much from his Gospel account. This series of sermons seeks to explore the miracles, parables and teachings of Jesus and find what Mark's Gospel has to say to us today

## PARABLES OF THE KINGDOM:

Seek ye first the Kingdom of God, and his righteousness, and all these things shall be added unto you, Hallelujah. We all know the song but do we understand the Kingdom. I am stuck by Jesus parable on the treasure in the field illustrating the Kingdom. The person who found it sold everything to get it, he understood its value
