A message from Frank Payne (Senior Pastor)

As a son of my heavenly Father, I have heard that familiar whisper that in the past has led me half way across the world. A voice that says "it is time to blow the trumpet; it is time to call my church to be ready for I your God am on the move in your land." Getting ready has something to do with this month's theme, "Restoring David's Fallen Tent". Restoration, God's will being done on earth, the Kingdom coming has as much to do with worship as it has with the expression of righteousness and justice in the land.

As the pastor of a local church about to reach out by opening our buildings as a community centre, we are, I am convinced, in tune with God's heart, as he says "knock down the walls surrounding you" As we reach out we must also respond to the call to restore David's tent seeing the church as a house of prayer for the nations. In using our buildings in a different way a dedicated space for pray and worship is essential for the church to use.

As the chair of Transform Bexley Borough I see God at work opening doors of opportunity to serve in ways not seen for many years. The question is: will the church be ready? If you have a passion for prayer and worship come and join us this month. Let's together seek a new anointing for worship. Let's rebuild David's tent.
